Our Programs

Promises Made (Diversion)

Case manager works to divert families from shelter and homelessness by assisting them to identify alternative housing options, services, or resources through case management services. This is for families who may be in imminent danger of losing their current housing.

Promise House (Shelter)

Families stay in homes, rented by Family Promise, for up to 120 days. During this time, the case manager works with families to establish and address goals including improving employment, household budgeting/financial literacy, connecting to entitlements, and securing permanent housing. Families also receive life skills training such as improving their credit credit and financial situation and building social networks to help them break the cycle of homelessness.

Promises Kept (Stabilization)

Offered to the graduates of Promise House, stabilization is necessary to reduce the rate of returns to shelter by families. By staying engaged with families as they exit the Promise Houses, we can limit the trauma experienced by the families. We provide food items, gift cards, small grants for one-time expenses, utility assistance, and furntiure or household items to families who stay in touch or attend meetings. Case management can also be provided.

New Initiatives in 2024

Promise of Food

This program's goal is to connect unserved fresh, pre-packed food from Landhope Foods with families participating in the Promise House shelter program. This collaboration aims to reduce food waste and provide essential nutrition to families experiencing homelessness. This program not only provides immediate relief in the form of fresh meals but also brings a sense of community and support to the shelter residents.



Promise of Clean Laundry

This is a volunteer program through The Sudsy Mama that provides free wash & fold laundry services to families facing homelessness. Each week, the volunteer paired with the family picks up, washes and folds, and returns the clean laundry back to the family. The Promise of Clean Laundry provides a financial relief but also reduces a family's stress and gives them back precious time that they can use to focus on themselves and their family.




